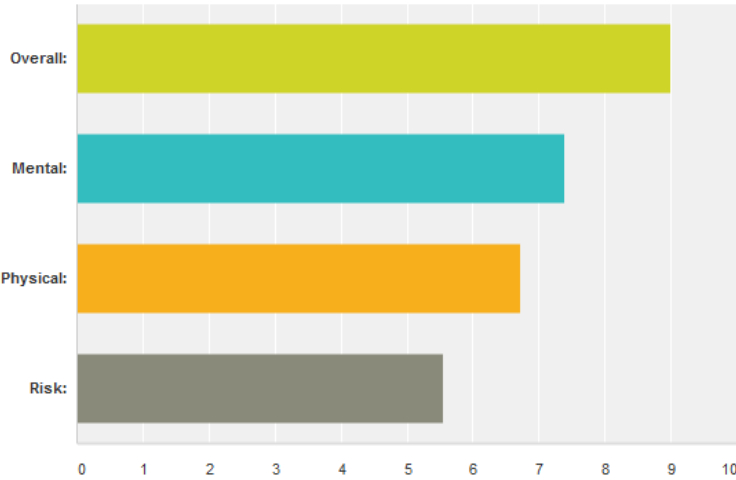
Here are the results of the overall game ratings from the online survey. For the responses to the other questions, including "What did you like best/least?" and "What needed improvement?", please examine the online survey!
