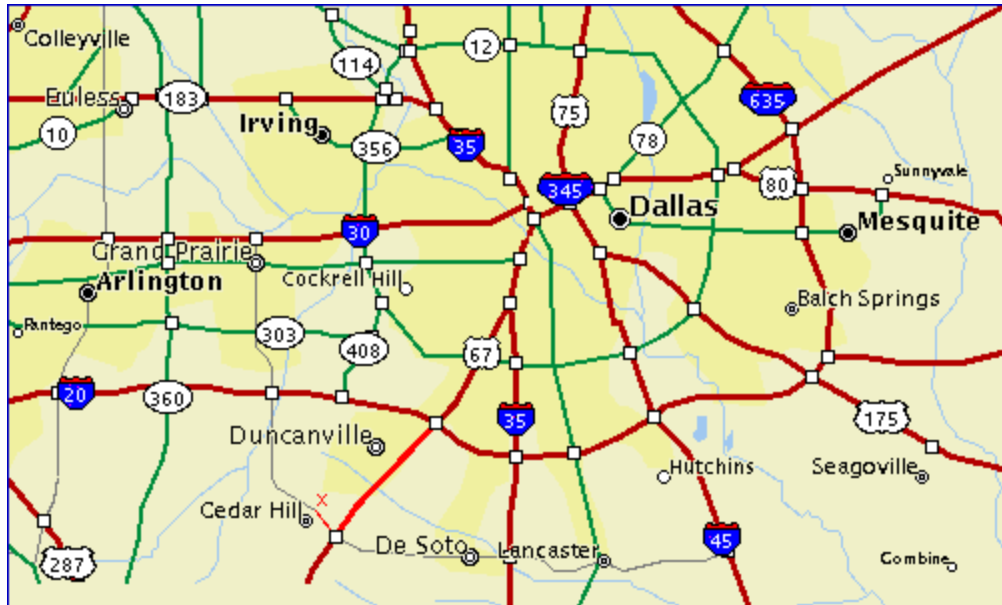


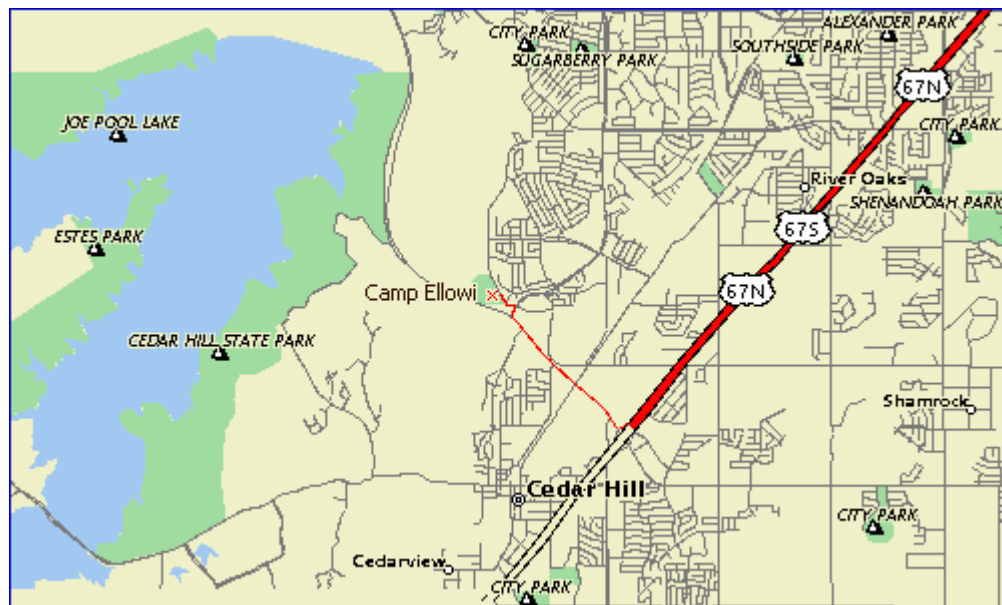
Camp Ellowi Campsite in Cedar Hill, TX.

From I-35, you need to exit onto I-20, westbound, and then exit onto Highway 67, southbound.



Once you are on Highway 67, you travel until you come to the exit for F.M. 1382. Not very far, and easily distinguishable by the number of fast-food places and such there. The signs also indicate the exit as going to Joe Pool Lake.

You will take this exit and take a right. If you need supplies, I suggest that you stop at the Krogers or K-Mart right there and get them, because they are the closest and you will probably end up back there later to get them anyway.



Now you will be travelling through a large group of fast food restaurants and such. Take a good look so that you know your options. Follow the road to the third stop light. The first will be flashing red in the middle of the strip of restaurants. The second will be past them with a bank on one corner. The third will be a three-way intersection. This is the one you want, N. Clark Road. It is easily distinguished by the fact that you will be at the bottom of a large rock wall beside the road. Turn right. Immediately after that you will need to get in the left-hand turn lane. Turn left onto Strauss Drive. Follow it carefully. The entrance to Camp Ellowi will be on your left.



It is a gravel driveway. There is a sign next to the gate that says "Camp Ellowi". Follow the driveway and park with the other vehicles. Beside the parking area is a metal gate. Walk through there and you're in the site. You may not drive onto the site.
