Magic Shop	Auction Board

Prizes will be awarded to the various winners of each event. In addition, PCs will have the opportunity to earn gold during the Jubilee.

There will be an extensive Magic Shop, and an Auction Board where PCs can advertise for items and can post items for sale.

There will also be a short line course called "Meeting of the Minds", which is open to all PCs. This one hour mini-game will be open to various levels, and will be a high-fighting, high risk, line course game.

There is no additional fee for the mini-game, but gamers who wish to participate must register for it before noon, and they must specify the PC that will be participating in the mini-game. All PCs who are registered for the mini-game must be on course by 1:00 pm.

The ratings for "Meeting of the Minds" are:

To get to Winter Park once you are in Dallas:

1. Head east on 635 from 35E.
2. Go north on 75 (Central Expressway) from 635.
3. Exit on Arapaho Road and head east (go left).
Continue past Plano, Jupiter, and Shiloh roads.
Arapaho dead-ends into North Garland Ave (NGA), which immediately turns north.
There is a large recreational area on the north-east corner of this intersection
(at your 10:00 position).
4. Go north (turn left) onto NGA and continue about 300 meters.
There will be soccer fields on the right-hand side of the road.
5. Go east (turn left) onto Spring Creek Way, a little street just to the north of the
soccer fields. This little road goes on for about 100 meters then "T"s into Spring
Creek Drive.
6. Go east (turn left) on Spring Creek Drive and look for the IFGS check-in stand in
one of the parking lots on the south side (your right) of the road.
If there's a lot of activity going on in the recreational area, we'll be in the
first parking lot by the school, otherwise we'll be in the second parking lot. Just
look for the other crazies in costume and the harried game producer!
7. Park, check-in, and get geared up.
